Swedish Volvo Cars and Egypt's Manufacturing Commercial Vehicles (MCV) have agreed to manufacture electric bus bodies for export to Europe

An agreement has been signed between the Swedish manufacturer Volvo Cars (subsidiary of the Chinese automotive group Geely) and the Egyptian company Manufacturing Commercial Vehicles (MCV), whose factory is located in Salheya, in the governorate of Ach-Charqiya.

In 2024, MCV will start manufacturing "bodies" (rigid sheet metal covering the vehicle chassis) for Volvo's city and intercity buses.

The equipment to be delivered from the first quarter of 2025.
