1. Activity of the Entreprise

In Morocco, **Alstom's** Fez plant was launched in 2011 with Nexans (Nexans has since left the joint venture).

Initially, it was a simple cabling unit. The site is gradually being transformed into an electrotechnical components factory. Alstom is starting to manufacture medium-power transformers for its metros, streetcars and regional trains worldwide, as well as electrical cabinets.

In 2023, Alstom Morocco started up a new production line for on-board transformers at its Fez site:

- Investment: 10.5 million euros.

- Surface area: 13,000 m².

- Staff: 500 employees

- Production capacity: 200 transformers per year.

This equipment is produced in Morocco and designed and industrialized by the Petit-Quevilly site (France).

The new plant is ISO 9001 and ISO 14001 certified.
