1. Activity of the enterprise

Chaudronnerie du Gabon (CDG) is located in the Nkok « Zone économique à Régime Privilégié » (ZERP). It recycles scrap metal recovered in Gabon, with a monthly production capacity of 5,000 tonnes of concrete reinforcing steel. The plant also processes manganese alloy scrap produced in Moanda in the south-east of the country.

The Nkok Zerp provides investors with :

- connection to the power plant via a 90 KVA high-voltage line
- two reservoirs with a total capacity of 6 million m³ of water per day to supply the zone
- a main electricity reception centre
- five relay substations
- 24 km of cable network
- a 20 KV high-voltage line
- a container terminal with a capacity of 1,500 TEU and 3,500 TEU.
