1. Activity of the Entreprise

Since 2011, Alstom's plant in Fez (Morocco) has gradually specialized in the manufacture of electrical cables and Mitrac transformers. Workforce: 1,000 people. The Fez plant is one of only two cable manufacturing facilities owned by Alstom worldwide. In 2020, an initial expansion was completed.

In 2023, Alstom Morocco launched a new production line for onboard transformers at the Fez site: Investment: €10.5 million; surface area: 13,000 m²; 500 employees; production capacity: 200 transformers per year. This equipment is manufactured in Morocco and designed by the Petit-Quevilly site (France). This new center is ISO 9001 and ISO 14001 certified and approved.

In December 2025, Alstom announced an investment of 100 million dirhams to create the world's first dedicated, multi-platform production line for train control panels. The equipment produced locally is intended for use in railway projects in several countries around the world. The announced expansion is expected to generate more than 200 direct jobs.
